Background, Methodology, and Organization of Report

A Joint Survey of Valencia Community College, Osceola Campus and the University of Central Florida was initiated in spring 2004 to inform the planned expansion of academic programs offered at the University of Central Florida at Osceola. For the Spring 2006 survey reported herein, the survey instrument was revised and the distribution was expanded to include all enrolled students as compared to the 2004 restricted survey population of students who had accumulated 45 credits or more.

UCF Operational Excellence and Assessment Support staff and a planning committee with membership from VCC and UCF designed the survey instrument collaboratively. The instrument was designed to assess VCC students' intended plans for further education. It can be found at the following link:

An email invitation was distributed to approximately ?? students who were taking courses at the VCC, Osceola Campus in Spring 2006. The email invitation from the Provost of the Osceola Campus explained the purpose and benefits of the survey, asked for cooperation, assured the confidentiality of results, and contained a link to the online survey. Two follow-up emails were also sent from the Provost, Osceola Campus. Surveys were collected between March, 24, 2006 and May 9, 2006. Completed surveys were received from 571 students, representing a response rate of ??% of the population.

A comparison of the survey sample characteristics to the population of eligible respondents was not available for this preliminary report. Seventy-nine percent of the sample is female and 21% are male. Fifty-four percent are age 24 or less, 23% are age 25-34 and the remaining 21% are 35 or older. Sixty-four percent of the respondents are pursuing an Associates of Arts degree, while 31% are pursuing an Associate of Science degree and 5% are not enrolled in a degree program.

A summary of the major findings is given. Frequency tables are shown for each question. Tables that show one question by another question are also given to provide a closer look at the results. Open-end comments will be summarized and presented in a separate document.

Major Findings

Major findings are summarized below.

- 78% (n=438) of the respondents plan to pursue a Baccalaureate degree in the next year or two, while 14% don't know, and 8% have no plans to do so.
- About 15% of respondents had met with a UCF adviser.
- 56% of respondents who are planning to pursue their Baccalaureate degree are planning to go to UCF.
- About 27 (n = 143) named a program other than those listed in the survey as their intended major.
- Of the academic programs included in the survey, respondents named two most often: Elementary Education with 15% (n=78); and Nursing with 16% (n=84).
- If offered, 69% (n = 373) of the respondents said they would take all their classes required for their major at UCF at Osceola.
- Most (43%; n=243) respondents commuted 15 minutes or less to the VCC, Osceola Campus while an additional 34% (n=192) commuted between 16 and 30 minutes.
