1. **Communication:** Graduating seniors will exhibit advanced written and oral comprehension of French at the level of *Avancé Moyen* to *Avancé Élevé* (advanced mid to advanced high) on the American Council of the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) scale. Additionally, graduating seniors will demonstrate their ability to produce written and spoken French at the level of *Avancé Moyen* to *Avancé Élevé* (advanced mid to advanced high) on the ACTFL scale.
2. **Critical Thinking:** Graduating seniors will demonstrate their critical thinking skills through the submission of a summative portfolio and a digital storytelling project. These assignments require students to apply their critical thinking skills to a variety of topics in order to edit and develop their ideas and language to meet the *Avancé Moyen* to *Supérieur* (advanced mid to superior) levels on the American Council of the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) scale.
3. **Goal-Setting and Self-Awareness:** Graduating seniors will submit evidence of a plan of study to be used to prepare the Exit Exam, and will engage in purposeful reflection that will foster a sense of responsibility and an openness to lifelong learning.
